SCFSA – Competition Stipends

The Space Coast Figure Skating Association is dedicated to promoting the sport of amateur figure skating at the Regional, Sectional, National and International Level in the various disciplines of Free Style, Dance, Pairs & Synchronized Teams. The SCFSA has established an Education/Scholarship Fund in accordance with the purposes of the Club as defined in Article II of the SCFSA Bylaws. The Board of Directors and Membership have authorized the following policy:

The Space Coast Figure Skating Association will provide financial assistance to help defray a portion of the expenses for SCFSA home club members who are competitive skaters entering USFSA Qualifying Competitions provided that adequate funds are available in the Education Fund. The skater must meet the criteria as specified below.

CRITERIA:

1. The applicant must be an eligible skater pursuant to USFSA rules and a HOME CLUB member of the SCFSA in good standing with the Club for a period of not less than one (1) year prior to the event for which reimbursement is being requested.
2. The applicant must complete the SCFSA Education Fund application. This application must be postmarked by thirty days prior to the event for which funds are being requested. No metered postmarks will be accepted. All applications must be mailed – NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. The applicant must show proof of participation in the event within thirty (30) days after the event is completed. This proof will consist of a printout of the event results.

NOTE: As regards criteria #1 above:

Memberships are due July 1 of each year. If not received by August 1, the membership will terminate and will only be restored by application as a NEW MEMBER. This means that you would not be eligible for funding for a year from when the membership is finally turned in. Thus timely renewal of membership is important.

The following Table provides the guidelines for the maximum amounts which are to be reimbursed for each of the events listed in the Table.

COMPETITION	MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT/SKATER
Qualifying Regionals	Entry fee for one event
Qualifying Adult Sectionals	Entry fee for one event
Sectionals	Stipend up to \$250 maximum
Junior Nationals	Stipend up to \$250 maximum
Championship Adult Nationals	Stipend up to \$250 maximum
U.S. Nationals	Stipend up to \$500 maximum
National Theater on Ice	Team Entry Fee
National Showcase	Entry Fee for one event
